1.	<b>Business Visa</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Letter of the local (Sudanese Company) giving brief profile of the company, identifying the applicant, sponsoring him and specifying the purpose of the visit.</li><li>2. Letter of invitation (sponsorship letter of Indian Company).</li><li>3. Business registration certificate.</li><li>4. Taxation certificate.</li><li>5. Certificate of Chamber of Commerce.</li><li>6. The applicant's business/visiting card.</li><li>7. Two photographs.</li><li>8. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li></ol>
2.	<b>Conference Visa</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Letter of the local company/institution giving brief profile of the company/institution, identifying the applicant, sponsoring him and specifying the purpose of the visit.</li><li>2. A letter of invitation from the conference organizer. Where relevant, the consular officer may also require proof of approval of the Indian authorities for holding the conference.</li><li>3. Confirmed return tickets.</li><li>4. Two photographs.</li><li>5. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li></ol>
3.	<b>Diplomatic Visa/ Official Visa</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Note Verbale from Ministry of Foreign Affairs.</li><li>2. Two photographs.</li><li>3. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li><li>4. Copy of air passage booking.</li></ol>

4.	<p><b>Employment Visa</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Copy of the employment contract from the company/organization in India.</li> <li>2. Bank statement in the name of applicant or an undertaking from parent/local guardian.</li> <li>3. Letter of the local Sudanese Company sponsoring him, giving brief profile of the company and identifying the applicant.</li> <li>4. Two photographs.</li> <li>5. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li> </ol>
5.	<p><b>Entry Visa</b></p> <p>[not covered by other type of visas viz. professional work, meetings, study tours, sport teams or longer stay]</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Letter of the local Sudanese Company sponsoring him giving brief profile of the company and identifying the applicant.</li> <li>2. Supporting evidence is required from the inviting organization in India.</li> <li>3. Bank statement in the name of applicant or an undertaking alongwith bank statement from parent/local guardian.</li> <li>4. Two photographs.</li> <li>5. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li> </ol>
6.	<p><b>Journalist Visa</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1 Only for professional journalists, media support crew and photographers. Letter of the local Sudanese Company sponsoring him giving brief profile of the company and identifying the applicant.</li> <li>2. Supporting evidence is required from the inviting organization in India.</li> <li>3. Bank statement in the name of applicant or an Affidavit alongwith bank statement of the sponsor.</li> <li>4. Two photographs.</li> <li>5. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li> </ol>

7.	<b>Medical Visa/ Medical Attendant Visa</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Preliminary medical advice from local Sudanese Doctor/Hospital</li> <li>2. Reference Letter from a reputed/recognized specialized hospital/ treatment center identifying the applicant.</li> <li>3. Bank statement in the name of applicant or an Affidavit alongwith bank statement of the sponsor.</li> <li>4. Two photographs.</li> <li>5. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li> </ol> <p>[Medical Attendant Visa is granted to the spouse/children or those who are blood relatives of the patient]</p>
8.	<b>Research Visa</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Eligibility/Admission Letter from a recognized educational institution in India. (Original and photocopy)</li> <li>2. A detailed synopsis of the research project, countersigned by the sponsoring institution in India</li> <li>3. Degree Certificates (Original and photocopy).</li> <li>4. Bank statement in the name of applicant or an Affidavit alongwith bank statement of the sponsor.</li> <li>5. Two photographs.</li> <li>6. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li> </ol>
9.	<b>Student Visa</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Eligibility/Admission Letter from a recognized educational institution in India. (Original and photocopy).</li> <li>2. Sudanese School Mark list duly attested by Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Original and photocopy).</li> <li>3. An Affidavit alongwith bank statement of the sponsor.</li> <li>4. Two photographs.</li> <li>5. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li> </ol>
	Student Visa (for students already studying in India and applying for visas for going back after completion of leave	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Certificate of the Educational Institute where studying.</li> <li>2. Residential permit/Exit permit issued by the District Police in India (Original and Photocopy).</li> <li>3. College Identity card.</li> <li>4. Two photographs.</li> <li>5. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li> </ol>

10.	<b>Tourist Visa</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Letter from Employer/Company identifying the applicant and specifying the purpose of visit and whether the applicant or the Employer/Company will be responsible for the applicant.</li><li>2. Bank statement in the name of applicant.</li><li>3. Confirmed return tickets.</li><li>4. Two photographs.</li><li>5. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li></ol>
11.	<b>Transit Visa</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Confirmed Air tickets.</li><li>2. Visas for country(ies) of destination.</li><li>3. Two photographs.</li><li>4. Passport should bear applicant's signature as on the application form.</li></ol>
